TRIP

A way for reducing travel costs is to take a flight only to Santiago, and from there travel to Concepción by bus (I recommend "EME BUS". Costs 35 to 40 Euro, buses lounge bed). The bus trip from Santiago to Concepcion takes about 6 hours. The bus terminal in Santiago is located in Av Libertador Bernardo O'Higgins 3714, Estación Central, Región Metropolitana. The transfer from the airport to Santiago bus terminal is expedited; there are transfer buses, taxis and private transfer (I recommend airport buses which are cheaper).

Arrival at the city of Concepcion

For those traveling from Santiago to Concepcion by bus, the bus terminal in Concepción is about 10 minutes from downtown by taxi (Costs 15 Euro approx.).

For those who arrive at the airport of Concepción, the transfer to the city can be done by taxi or private transfer (costs are around 13 to 15 Euro). The trip takes 10 to 15 minutes. If needed we can also go to the airport to receive you.

COSTS

The conference fee will be 400.00 Euro per delegate for the conference and field trip, including: lunch and coffee breaks (Tuesday to Thursday), Congress dinner (Wednesday), transfer to Termas de Chillán (Valle Las Trancas), accommodations in Valle Las Trancas and all meals during the field trip. Alcoholic drinks are excluded. The fee does not include the costs for the hotel in the city of Concepción (Monday to Thursday), the organizer is currently trying to find cheap opportunities for that (see <http://www.geometridosdechile.cl/>).

Note: I ask you to confirm your attendance to the conference and/or field trip by E-Mail until September 30. You can book your place by confirming your participation in writing and by paying a deposit of 200 Euro (see item 1 above for registration form). The remaining payment can be made directly on January 10, 2017 in cash.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SENDING ABSTRACTS

THE DEADLINE FOR SENDING ABSTRACTS EXPIRES SEPTEMBER 30, 2016

The format of the abstracts should consider the following instructions and should be sent exclusively in Word format (doc or docx) via email to luparra@udec.cl

Language: English.

Font: Times New Roman 12.

Text: Single space, left and right bound.

Margins: Top, bottom and left 2,05 cm; right 2.0 cm.

Length: Maximum 280 words (without considering title, author name and affiliation).

Text content: Please present an introduction to the problem, methodology, main results and conclusion (s).

Title: in capital letters and bold, italicized scientific names indicating the family in parentheses. Leave one line between the title and the name of the authors, you should give full names, separated by a comma. Please indicate the presenter's name and e-mail address.

The affiliation of the authors should be indicated by numbers (superscript) referring to the name and address of the institution.

Please leave a free line between the address(es) of author(s) and keywords (minimum three; maximum five).

A line is subsequently left free before the text begins.

At the bottom of the text you should specify the preferred type of presentation (oral or poster). Abstracts will be evaluated by an editorial committee, which may suggest – in certain cases – to the authors to change from oral presentation to poster or vice versa.

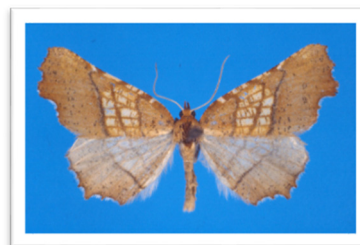
Each participant may submit up to two presentations as first author (one oral and one poster). The evaluating committee may, however, make single exceptions from that rule. There are no limits for presentations in co-authorship.

Instruction for Poster: Posters need to be presented in upright format, with a maximum size of 90 cm wide x 120 cm high.
